We also recognise that other year groups have important assessments taking place, including the Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check and the Year 1 Phonics Screening in the coming weeks. We wish all of these children the very best and know they will approach them with the same enthusiasm and resilience.

Finally, we hope our Year 6 pupils enjoyed their SATs breakfast each morning, and we extend a **special thank you to Carol** for making this possible.

CAN YOU HELP?

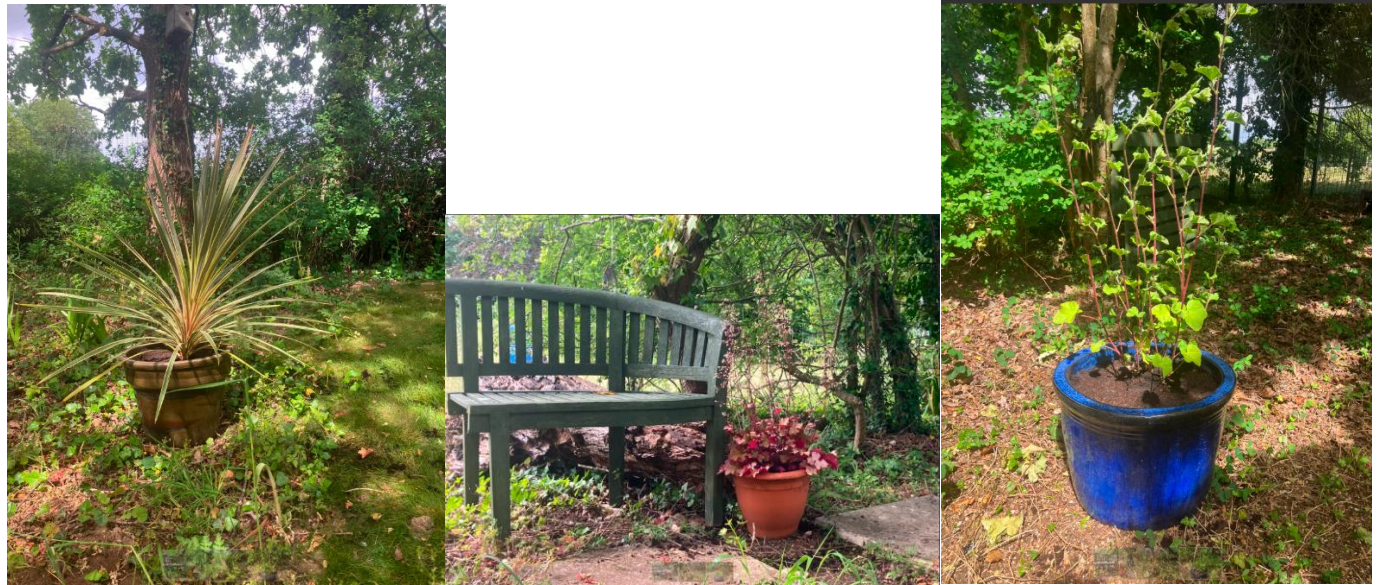
We are currently developing our new sensory garden and would greatly appreciate your support in helping us create a welcoming and enjoyable space for the children.

SITE IMPROVEMENTS

We are delighted to share that we were fortunate to receive a generous donation from a development company, via Oxfordshire County Council, which has helped to support the recent improvements to our school environment.

We are pleased to confirm that the outdoor works in Owlets are now fully complete, and the improvements look great. The newly installed fencing has made a significant and very welcome difference to the space, creating a safer, more secure, and clearly defined area for the children to enjoy.

In addition to the outdoor works, we have also recently been able to update the washing facilities within the Year 1 and Early Years bathroom, alongside the installation of new staff toilets. These upgrades represent an important improvement to the school environment, ensuring cleaner, more modern, and more practical facilities for both pupils and staff.

We're also excited to share that the Barn Owls have also created their own outdoor play space just outside their classroom! This special area provides the children with additional opportunities to explore, play and learn in the fresh air throughout the day.

Having direct access to an outdoor space encourages independence, supports physical development, and promotes creativity through open-ended play. It also gives the children a chance to develop their social skills, and enjoy a calm and stimulating environment alongside their classroom learning.

Before half term, Bright Sparks joined us in assembly to deliver a fun, exciting and interactive science show, which the children really enjoyed. The session gave them a great introduction to the kinds of hands-on experiments and fascinating scientific ideas they will explore.

We are pleased to let you know that a **Bright Sparks Science Club** will be starting on **Monday 18 June**. The club will run for **6 weeks**,

with sessions taking place each week from **3:15pm–4:15pm**. It promises to be a fantastic opportunity for children to develop their curiosity, creativity and enthusiasm for science in an enjoyable and supportive environment.

Parents of children in **Years 1–6** will have received an email with full details on how to book a place for your child.



TRANSITION DAY

As the end of the school year approaches, we are beginning preparations to support pupils as they move into their new year groups and classes.

Our whole-school transition day will take place on **Wednesday 8 July**. This session gives all children the opportunity to spend time in their new year group alongside the pupils and staff they will be working with in September.

Throughout the term, children will have opportunities to talk about and prepare for upcoming changes, as well as additional chances to become familiar with new staff and classmates.

Due to our mixed-year classes, many children will benefit from remaining with the same teacher for a second year. For those children who will be moving to a new teacher, staff will meet before the end of term to share information and discuss individual needs to ensure a smooth transition.

Parents of Year 6 children will receive details of secondary school transition days directly from their chosen secondary school. Staff from each destination secondary school will also arrange visits to Dry Sandford to meet with pupils and staff.

We kindly ask that parents inform the school office of any transition visits their child will be attending so that we can record and authorise their absence from school.

If you have any questions regarding transition arrangements, please speak to your child's class teacher or Mrs Friday.

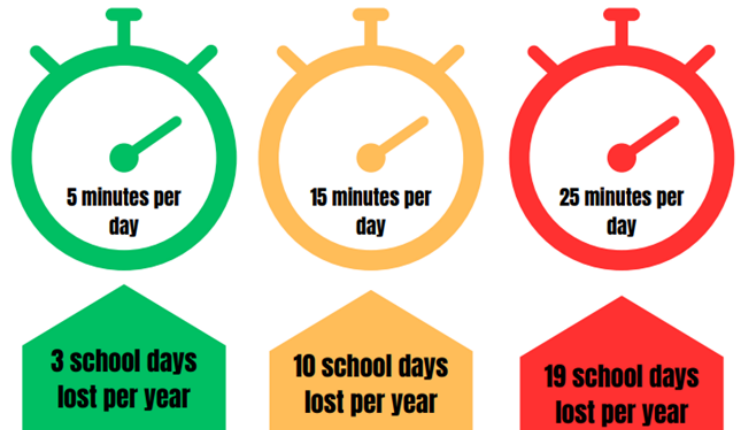

ATTENDANCE UPDATE

Oxfordshire County Council require us to monitor both individual and overall attendance data on a regular basis. Our whole-school attendance rate is currently around 94%, which, while positive, remains below the local authority's target of 97%. We are continually working to improve this and appreciate the important role families play in helping us achieve this goal.

Regular attendance is essential for children's academic progress, social development, and overall wellbeing. Missing even small amounts of school can quickly add up and impact learning, friendships, and confidence. Establishing good attendance habits from an early age helps children to develop a strong sense of routine, responsibility, and belonging within the school community.

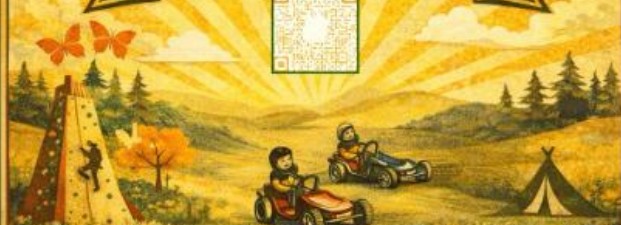
