## MULTI-SPORTS MORNING

The school day will begin as normal, with children being dropped off at their usual classroom or cloakroom door at 8.40am. Parents are then welcome to wait on the school field while we register the children, organise the teams, and bring everyone outside. We aim to begin the event at approximately 9.15am.

Throughout the morning, all children will take part in a range of sporting activities, earning points for their House. Teams will rotate around the different activity stations, including a hydration station. Parents are encouraged to follow their child's group around the activities so they can watch and cheer them on.

## UPDATES TO AFTER SCHOOL CLUB

We would like to inform you of some updates to our afterschool provision.

Due to its continued popularity, we have reviewed our pricing and updated some of our procedures. Please read the following carefully:

- **Hoots Afterschool Club** will now be charged at **£6.50 per hour**.
- **Breakfast Club** will now be charged at **£5.50 per hour**.
- All places must be booked in advance, as the office is no longer able to accept late booking requests.
- If your child is absent from school due to illness, any pre-booked sessions will still be charged.
- If a place is booked and your child is collected early (for example, due to an appointment or illness), or you notify the office of a change such as your child walking home or being collected by another responsible adult, the session will still be charged.
- If you book for 2 hours but your child is collected within the first hour, you will still be charged for the full 2-hour session.
- If you need to cancel a booked session, **a minimum of 24 hours' notice must be given**. Cancellations made with less than 24 hours' notice will still be charged.

These changes help us to manage staffing levels effectively and ensure places are available for all families who need them.

## A HEARTFELT THANK YOU TO OUR FAMILIES

We would like to extend our heartfelt thanks to all our parents and carers for your incredible support throughout this academic year.

Your generous donations through Amazon have made a real difference to our school. From much-needed classroom resources to enrichment materials, your kindness has helped enhance the learning experience for all our pupils.

We are also incredibly grateful for the many ways you have supported us at events throughout the year. Whether helping to make World Book Day, our Easter celebrations, World Diversity Day, and the Christmas raffle so special, donating items for hampers, providing delicious cakes for cake sales, or contributing so generously to the Summer Fete, your involvement has been truly invaluable.

The effort and generosity shown in helping us raise funds and create memorable experiences for the children does not go unnoticed. We simply could not do it without your support.

Many families have asked how fundraising benefits the school. To give some context, a full class set of laptops, including a charging trolley and the necessary software and safeguarding set-up for school use, costs approximately **£22,000**. As we currently have only **10 out of 15** older laptops in working order, these devices will need to be replaced on a rolling programme over time.

Similarly, the interactive whiteboards used in classrooms—now more commonly known as interactive panels cost around **£2,700** each, including installation. These panels are an essential teaching resource, functioning much like a large tablet mounted on the wall and supporting interactive learning across the curriculum.

Thank you once again for everything you do to support our school community. Your generosity, time, and commitment are very much appreciated and make a genuine difference to the opportunities we can provide for our children.
